

# 17. DETERMINERS

Word that comes before a noun to show how the noun is being used is known as determiner.

We have already read about a , an , the. Now, we shall read about possessive determiners(my, our, your, his, her, its and their).



### **POSSESSIVE DETERMINERS:**

A possessive determiner is a word that shows possession and followed by a noun.

- 1. My, our, your, his, her, its, their are possessive determiners.
- 2. Possessive determiners are always followed by nouns.But possessive pronouns are never followed by nouns.
