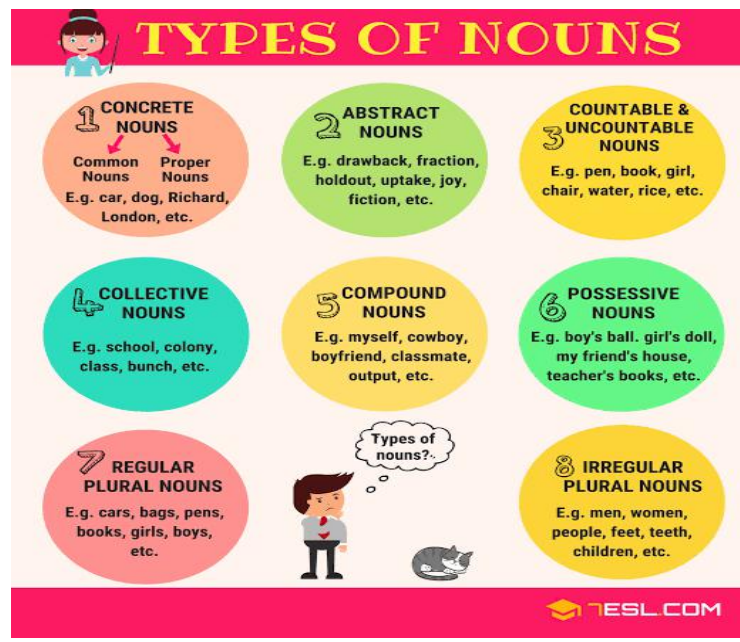

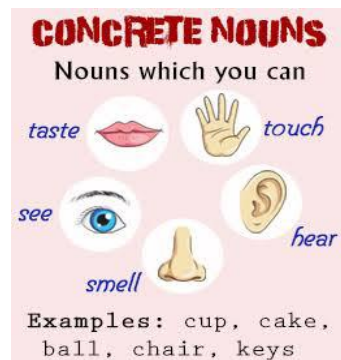

## 8. NOUNS - CONCRETE, ABSTRACT

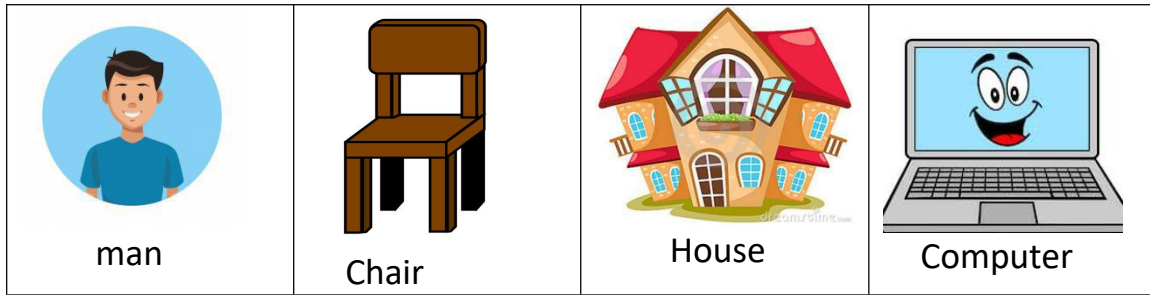


Nouns are naming words. They name persons, places, animals, or things. Nouns may be concrete or abstract.

### A. CONCRETE NOUNS



Concrete Nouns name things that we can see and touch; as -



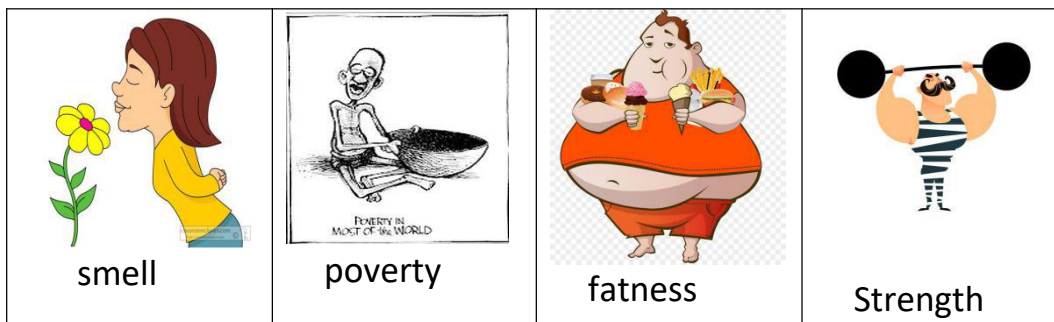
## B. Abstract Nouns

### ABSTRACT NOUN

Name of anything which can neither be seen nor be touched but can be felt is called abstract noun.

An abstract noun is usually the name of a quality, action, or state that cannot be seen or touched as;
